S3 FULL REPORT

A report on progress in S3 has been handed out today. The Report consists of a grade for effort, behaviour and homework with the following ratings:

Excellent (1)	A pupil will have gone above and beyond the normal expectations to be awarded excellent – e.g. handing homework in early, always contributing during whole class discussion and group work, test scores are always very high.
Good (2)	Pupils who follow the expectations and standards required at school consistently.
Inconsistent (3)	Pupils will mainly follow the expectations and standards required but they do not always do this – e.g. homework may be late, test scores are below what teacher would expect.
Needs Improvement (4)	Pupils rarely follow rules, expectations and standards. Pupils will have received referrals or a significant number of demerits.

The Report will indicate the Level in Curriculum for Excellence achieved in each subject. Teachers will also indicate how well your son/daughter is progressing towards the next level; the skills being developed; recommended level for S4 and how you can help at home.

The Report includes a behaviour record of merits, demerits and referrals.

- Merits recognise behaviour which exceeds expectations.
- Demerits are recorded for minor learning or discipline issues.
- Referrals record more significant issues.

Also enclosed is a summary of attendance this year.


