DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COLLEGE ACADEMY COURSES FROM AUGUST 2025

Your child has elected to study a course delivered by Dumfries and Galloway College during session 2025/26. Courses run at different times and details are in the table on the next page.

Transport will be provided on both afternoons however, if a student is attending college for a full day, they will require to ensure that they have applied for a free bus pass (young Scot card) with the Scottish Government for morning trips.

Students studying on either afternoon, will go to the social space to eat lunch during period 5. Students must bring either a packed lunch or pre-order lunch from the canteen. They will not have time to go down the street to purchase anything. They will be registered on the buses in the bus park at 12.45pm. Day 1, they will be met by their lecturers and escorted to their classes before returning to the buses for 4.30pm at the college bus park. Students studying Automotive skills at the bridge, will be taken to the bridge after students are dropped off at the college (around 1.40pm) and will be collected around 4.45pm at the bridge. All students will return to Lockerbie Academy for around 5.15-5.30pm. Students can be dropped off in Lochmaben High Street. Any student requiring further bus travel once having returned to school, should ensure they have their Young Scot card for free bus travel.

- If your child only attends college on a Tuesday afternoon, you can choose to allow your child to study offsite on a Thursday afternoon (child signs out at 12.20pm).

Funding transport

Last year the college buses cost the school in excess of £12,000, and this must be paid from the whole school budget. This would work out as approximately £116 per child this year without inflation. As a school we want to support students accessing these courses and we are asking parents/carers to support our transport costs from one of the following options:

- I am able to contribute £55 towards the cost of transport for my child
- I am able and willing to contribute more than £55 towards the cost of transport for my child
- I would need support with the cost of transport
