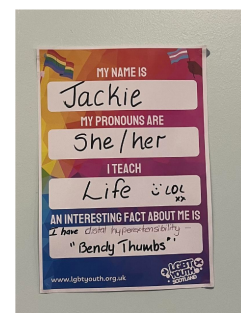
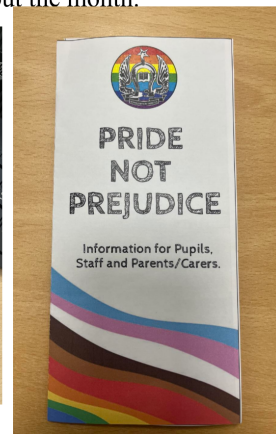

June was Pride Month, an annual celebration commemorating the contributions of the LGBTQIA+ community. Throughout the month of June we had a number of opportunities for pupils, staff and parents/carer's to get involved in:



- Relaunch of staff pronoun **door signs**.
- Information on how staff can include their **pronouns** on their identification badges.
- **Pride Month** powerpoint to be shown during registration/PSE.
- Updated information and signposting to support agencies on the **school website**.
- Launch of '**Need To Talk**': All pupils can access support from staff by completing the form and sharing their concerns or worries relating to LGBT. A member of the PTPS team will follow this up. The QR code is located around the school and on the school website.
- **Move With Pride Challenge**: Staff and pupils were challenged to walk, run or cycle as many miles as possible to show their support for the LGBTQIA+ community.
- Launch of our **LGBT Information Leaflet**: Produced by the Pride Not Prejudice Group our new leaflet is for pupil, staff and parents/carers to share our journey.
- Members of Senior Management also wore **rainbow lanyards** throughout the month.
