towards free books for our school library.

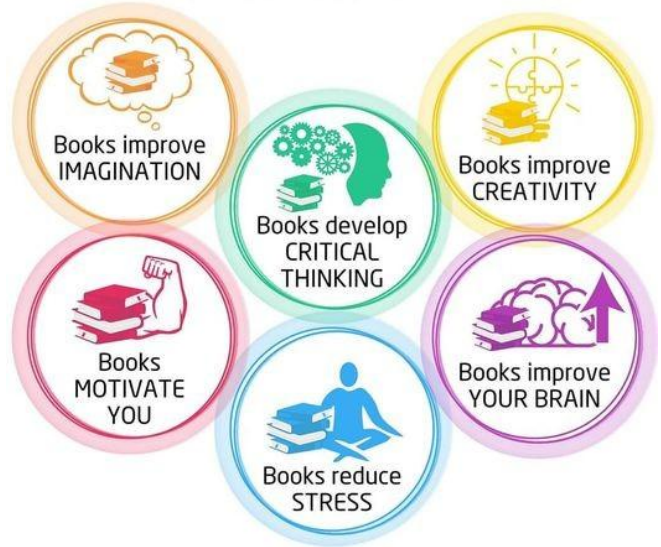
