S4-6 Interventions 2025-26

As part of our plan to raise student attainment this year, we are adding another layer of support for students that are identified as underperforming in several subject areas. Currently students understand their performance and next steps through the following pathways –

- Tracker reports (4 times per year)
- Learning conversations between themselves and their teachers about where they are now and what steps they need to take to improve
- October assessments and prelim feedback
- Parent/carers evenings

We know that some students need a bit of bit extra support and all staff have been trained in coaching and mentoring techniques to mentor their allocated student by taking them through the 'GROW' coaching model.

G = **Goal** – What does the student want to achieve?

R = **Reality** – Where are they now?

O = **Opportunities** – what is available to help bridge the gap, what are the options?

W = **Way Forward** – create an action plan with steps to improvement

Interventions will take place at three points in the year and will involve either 2 or 3 one to one meetings between the student and mentor (Nov/Dec-Jan/Feb – March). Students are selected based on their tracking data to date.

Parents/Carers will receive a separate message at each of these points to indicate that their child has been selected to participate.
