All pupils in third year in Scottish schools undertake the Scottish National Standardised Assessment (SNSA) each year. The purpose of the assessment is to provide information for teachers about pupil progress in Literacy and Numeracy and to help guide learning and teaching. The assessments are also designed to produce national-level information about pupils' progress for the Scottish Government. National level information covers the whole of Scotland and not individual schools. Your child will complete the assessment in the coming weeks.
