Dear Parent/Carer,

As we reach the end of January, I would like to take this opportunity to update you on progress at Lockerbie Academy and to thank you for your continued support during a busy and purposeful start to 2026.

January has been a settled month across the school. Pupils have returned from the winter break focused, well-presented and ready to learn. Across S1–S6, learning in classrooms has been calm, respectful and increasingly aspirational, with young people engaging positively with lessons and demonstrating our school values of **Compassion, Achieve, Respect and Equity** in their daily interactions.

Our senior pupils deserve particular recognition. Throughout January they have approached prelims, assessments and revision sessions with maturity and determination. Attendance and punctuality for senior pupils during this demanding period has been encouraging, and staff have been impressed by the resilience and commitment shown. We are continuing to support all learners to reflect on progress, identify next steps and aim high as we move towards the exam diet. Easter School will be offered, and all seniors will be encouraged to attend. More information will be sent home in the next week for seniors to sign up. Easter School will take place across both weeks of spring break (Monday 30th March / Wednesday 1st April / Tuesday 7th April / Wednesday 8th April / Thursday 9th April).

Across the wider school, we have seen positive engagement in learning, improving routines between lessons and a strong sense of pride in the school environment. Staff continue to reinforce high expectations around behaviour, relationships and learning, ensuring Lockerbie Academy remains a safe, respectful place for all.

As shared previously, we continue our improvement journey following feedback from HMIE. Our focus remains firmly on raising attainment and achievement for all learners through consistent high-quality learning and teaching, effective use of data, and targeted support where it is needed most. Staff are working collaboratively to strengthen practice, and pupils are increasingly involved in understanding their own progress and next steps in learning. I will continue to keep you informed as this work progresses. Part of this journey involves you, and I share now our Stakeholder Survey. Staffing updates shared earlier in the month remain mostly unchanged. Central officers continue to support the school, and I remain fully committed to leading Lockerbie Academy forward with stability, clarity and ambition for our young people.
