TRIP TO THE ALTON TOWERS RESORT

Dear Parent/Guardian

On Thursday 28 May 2026 we are planning to visit the Alton Towers resort in Staffordshire. This will be an excursion made available to any S1-S3 pupil; however, there are a set number of spaces with a limit of 93 pupils being able to attend. If the trip is oversubscribed, then names will be drawn from a hat.

The total cost of this trip is £65. This involves a whole day ticket into the resort, with your child having the opportunity to experience all rides and attractions which they wish to. This fee will cover the cost of the transport to and from the resort. As we will need to travel for several hours to reach the resort the coaches will leave early on the Thursday morning and arrive back late that night.

As you will see from their report, all risks have been accounted for and limited wherever possible so as to ensure the pupils personal safety during the excursion. Pupils will be unsupervised throughout the day but staff will be contactable and check in times will be arranged that all pupils must attend.

A more detailed itinerary and information sheet will be sent home closer to the day we leave. However the proposed plan is as follows (times are subject to change) -

- 5:00 am – Coaches depart Lockerbie Academy
- 7:00 am – Toilet break at services
- 9:00 am – Arrive at the Alton Towers resort
- 5:30 pm – Depart the Alton Towers resort
- 7:30 pm – Toilet break at services
- 9:30 pm – Arrive back at Lockerbie Academy
