How Parents & Carers Can Support Learning

Your support at home makes a real difference.



What can you do to help?

1 Support Attendance & Punctuality

- Ensure your child attends school every day and arrives on time.
- Avoid unnecessary absences during term time.
- Let us know early if there are barriers affecting attendance.



Good attendance = better progress and attainment.

2 Encourage Engagement With Learning

- Ask about learning intentions and what success looks like in lessons.
- Encourage completion of classwork, homework and revision.
- Promote positive study routines at home.



Small, regular conversations about learning matter.

3 Support Literacy & Numeracy At Home

You can help by:

- Encouraging regular reading (fiction, non-fiction, news, online articles).
- Talking about learning and current topics.
- Supporting basic numeracy skills such as time, money, data and problem-solving.



Literacy and numeracy are everyone's responsibility - at school and at home.

4 Support Success

- Encourage regular revision and organisation of coursework.
- Support attendance at targeted support or intervention sessions (study support, Easter school, online revision platforms).

5 Encourage High Expectations

- Talk positively about learning and qualifications.
- Encourage your child to aim for the highest level they are capable of.
- Reinforce resilience, effort and perseverance.

6 Work In Partnership With The School

- Engage with tracking, reporting and parents' evenings
- Respond to communication from school
- Contact us early if you have concerns about progress, wellbeing or attendance.
