Success Area	Guidance
Achievement Award	The Achievement award goes pupils who perform best in S1 based on course work / assessment data (Faculties can nominate up to 5 pupils in each class)
Endeavour Award	(combination of some of these, in the professional judgement of the teacher – no restriction on the number of nominations staff may make- but would not be awarded to pupils receiving Achievement Award) ❖ Brings all equipment required ❖ Consistently tries hard ❖ Is always willing to participate in class discussion/activity ❖ Always completes homework on time ❖ Does not get punishment exercises or detention ❖ Contributes fully in a positive way to the ethos of the department. ❖ Is consistently performing to the best of their ability ❖ Reaching or exceeding expectations ❖ Battling / overcoming adversity

Achieving a Level:

To receive an award, pupils will need to meet criteria in 3 or more areas. Once this has been achieved, the following formula should be used to determine the level of award-

Platinum- 4

Gold- 3

Silver- 2

Bronze- 1

From the **best** 3 areas; add points together and divide by 3.

Examples

Pupil A: Bronze x1, Silver x2 = $1+2+2=5$ divided by 3 = 1.6 (round up to 2) = SILVER

Pupil B: Bronze x1, Gold x1, Platinum x1 = $1+3+4=8$ divided by 3 = 2.6 = GOLD

Pupil C: Silver x2, Gold x1 = 7 divided by 3 = 2.3 (round down to 2) = SILVER
