What is the Pupil Equity Fund?

The Pupil Equity fund is money given to schools to help bridge the attainment gap for pupils living in poverty.

The school receives £1225 for each pupil from S1-3 who is entitled to free school meals.

The money can be used how the school feels would best help these targeted pupils.

All uses of PEF money must be reported on and evidence of impact tracked and monitored.
